Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to our faith community at Megan Furth Catholic Academy! As a Catholic School, we do offer a program of Sacramental Preparation for Baptism, First Holy Communion, Reconciliation, and Confirmation. At this time I am asking for the names of students who desire to receive the sacraments. Students may be baptized at any age. Second Grade students, who are Catholic, may receive their First Holy Communion this year, as well as older students who may not have received their First Holy Communion. Students who have received their First Holy Communion will also have the opportunity to go to confession. This is the sacrament of Reconciliation. Students in Grades 7 and 8 may ask to be confirmed in the Catholic Church.

Parents, we do continue to have a Religious Education Planning Team: Sister Ann Providence, O.P., Mrs. Nicole McAuliffe, Father Xavier Lavagetto, O.P., and Deacon Chuck McNeil.

Our program is designed to allow students a preparation time for the Sacraments. I anticipate that Baptisms for MFCA students will be planned for a Sunday after Easter, 2011. I will confirm the date as soon as possible. I anticipate that First Holy Communion will be scheduled for May 8, 2011, which is also Mother's Day! The dates for Confirmation at St. Mary's Cathedral are Saturday, May 14th at 10 a.m. or Sunday, May 22, at 3:30 p.m.

This year we ask that students preparing for the sacrament of Confirmation be either in the Seventh or the Eighth Grade. This allows the students a greater understanding of their Catholic faith before they make a lifelong commitment!

For those students who want to receive sacraments in the Catholic Church, we ask that you complete and return the form at the bottom of this page, by **THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 9!!!** I look forward to working with you and your children, as we all grow in our relationship with God, through Jesus Christ, our Lord.
